



## COVID Protocols/Info

### As of November 1, 2021

We are a definite “go” with an in-person event for the 2021 NSCA School Counselor Academy on November 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> but we are committed to doing so in a safe way. Our protocols below are based on two things. First, recommendations from local health experts including a Directed Health Measure that is currently in effect for Lincoln and Lancaster County through Thanksgiving. Secondly, school counselors as a whole are committed to helping and protecting others. We plan to provide an environment where everyone can re-connect, meet new colleagues, celebrate each other, and learn while feeling safe and being safe.

All NSCA School Counselor Academy participants (attendees, exhibitors, presenters and volunteers) are required to wear a face covering that covers their mouth and nose at all times while attending the 2021 School Counselor Academy with the following exceptions:

- Presenters may remove their masks while presenting as long as they remain 6 or more feet away from all other people.
- Masks may be removed while actively eating or drinking.
- Masks may be removed while seated at the luncheon on Thursday and Friday.
