

TITLE: School Counseling Ethics during a Global Pandemic

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DESCRIPTION: School counselors have been uniquely challenged during COVID-19 to provide equitable services to all students both remotely and in person. In addition, the political climate brought about by a contentious election, the civil unrest following the killing of unarmed black Americans including Ahmaud Arbery, George Floyd, Breonna Taylor, and the shooting of Jacob Blake, leaves us wondering how do we simultaneously and ethically support all students regardless of their values and beliefs while challenging systemic barriers and making sure marginalized students feel safe? These and other ethical concerns will be examined with a review of how to make ethical decisions.
